2. AOD Guidelines for Safe School Re-Opening – Betsy Gabrish
Impact to:
 - a. PSA events -
 1. Afterschool Enrichment – No after school activities at this time. Still waiting to hear about Volleyball.
 2. Hot Lunch Program – No parents allowed in the school at this time therefore we cannot offer hot lunch service.

3. Budget Update – Lisa Collias
 - a. PSA Donation Drive – postponed until further notice
 - b. Future fundraising to be considered later in the year
 - c. PSA Dues? \$20 per family, a portion of the proceeds go to Fun Day T-shirts K – 7th grade.
 1. Fun Day t-shirts – Fun Day t-shirts should be purchased on line by each family individually on the same website as Crusader Sprit Wear <https://shopcrusaders.com/home/>. If all families purchase their own t-shirts, we can reduce our PSA fee to \$10/family.
 2. We are starting the 2020-2021 school year with approximately \$7,700 in our PSA budget. **ACTION** → Lisa is looking to use the FACTS Online payment process for families to pay dues
 3. **ACTION** → Ann to send a communication to the families explaining the purchase of Fun Day t-shirts and PSA Dues. This can be done in the next few months once the FACTS payment system is up and running

4. PSA Events (discussion to determine if events can move forward in modified format to comply with AOD Guidelines)
 - a. Trunk-or-Treat –
 - a. Chairperson = Nelda Shunyia – When: tentatively scheduled for Friday 10/9/20 – the event will be divided up into three groups to decrease the number of people gathered in one location for the event: Estimating 132 kids
 - i. Pumpkins 3:30-4:30pm - PreK3 -2,
 - ii. Goblins 4:45-5:45pm - Grades 3-5 and
 - iii. Zombies 6-7pm – Grades 6 - 8.
 - iv. If you have multiple children, go to the oldest child's time.
